<u>First-aid</u>: Pacific Coast Marine Safety Code (PCMSC) states that the employer must provide fully stocked and maintained first-aid kits and displayed in a prominent position at each terminal. When goggles and respirators are required they shall be provided by the employer and utilized in accordance with rule 612. Protective equipment, such as protective clothing, gloves, goggles, etc. shall be provided whenever there is an exposure to a hazardous condition. When administering first-aid please protect yourself from any possible transfer of blood or bodily fluids that may be contaminated by wearing all your protective equipment.

Do Not wait to see if the lashing order is filled. Foremen must be ordered first!!
