LABOR DAY'S HOLIDAY PAY SCHEDULE: Monday September 3<sup>th</sup> is a **NO** work day (except for rails, military, passenger, or perishables) and a *paid holiday*. To be eligible for Labor Day holiday pay, you must work or be available for work at least 2 days of the week, Tuesday through Friday. Monday September 3<sup>rd</sup> does **not** count as one of the days of availability. **Flops** do not count as a day of availability. Vacation claims must include Monday through Friday of the respective Holiday week and **filed with the office prior to the Holiday to be paid for the holiday. Late filing will result in nonpayment of the holiday.**

HOLIDAY DISPATCH: We will be dispatching Sunday September 2<sup>nd</sup> between **1:00 pm and 2:00 pm** for Sunday night 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> shifts, and any work that is ordered for **Labor Day** (day or night) **Monday September 3<sup>rd</sup>** (Rails, Military, Passenger, or Perishables only) and for **Dayside Tuesday, September 4<sup>th</sup>**. Please when checking in be clear on what shift you are checking in for and if you would like to travel.

**TWIC Card Readers:** Will be going into effect at facilities that handle vessels carrying 1000 plus passengers on August 23, 2018. The Employers have a duty to bargain with the Union over all discretionary aspects of the TWIC program: until such times as the TWIC card readers are made mandated by federal law, they cannot be used by PMA and its member companies. Regardless of any federal mandate, TWIC is not a condition of employment under the PCL&CA (reference Coast Award C-8-09), which means that the Employers cannot use aspects of the TWIC program as a basis for disciplinary action on the PCL&CA.
