STOP WORK MEMBERSHIP MEETING

Thursday, February 6, 2020 7 PM at the Cruise Terminal S.P. 93

Executive Board: This month's meeting will be Tuesday, February 4, 2020 at 11:30 AM.

Paid Holidays: Martin Luther King's birthday Monday, January 20th is a paid Holiday, paid at the overtime rate of pay, and a normal workday. Lincoln's Birthday Wednesday, February 12th is paid at the overtime rate of pay, and a normal workday. Washington's Birthday Monday February 17th is a paid Holiday, paid at the overtime rate of pay, and a normal workday.

Nominations for all offices: Nomination Forms are available in the business office immediately following the January meeting and shall remain available until thirty-six (36) hours following the March Membership Meeting and must be received by the Secretary Treasurer no later than **12 noon Friday, March 6, 2020.**

Elections: shall be held for all offices and Committees on **Friday, March 13th**. To apply for an elective position, you must have been a member of Local 94 and in good standing for the previous 12 months and any fines and/or assessments owed must be paid prior to close of nominations or you shall be removed from the ballot.

Any Candidate who wishes to have an observer on their behalf at the polling location and/or for the counting of the ballots may do so by submitting a request in writing. This request listing the name of the observer and for which candidate they will be observing for must be received by the Secretary Treasurer no later than 24 hours prior to the polls opening (**6 am Thursday, March 12, 2020.**)

Voting: Our General Election will take place **Friday March 13, 2020** at Local 63 between the hours of **6 AM** and **7 PM.**

Absentee ballot: Members that meet the criteria of Article VI of the Foremen's Union Local 94 Constitution and By-Laws Section 1. **Absentee Ballot** "Sick and injured members, and those members away who wish to vote in an election, can do so by applying to the Secretary-Treasurer for an absentee ballot" This must be done by **12 noon on Friday, March 6, 2020** and returned by **Friday, March 13, 2020** no later than **3 PM,** (the instructions will be included).

If a Run – Off Election is needed your Absentee request must be made by **12 noon on Friday, March 13, 2020** and returned by **Friday, March 20, 2020** no later than **3 PM.**



The Run – Off Election: if needed will take place on **Friday, March 20, 2019** between the hours of **6 AM** and **7 PM** at Local 63.

General Rule #1: "All active members are required to vote at all elections, regular or special, or be fined **\$50** for failure to do so, except sick or injured members, or members on vacation and vacation is on file with the Secretary-Treasurer".

As per the Constitution and By-Laws a Trustee is prohibited from holding another elective office, a nominee may only run for the office of Trustee or for any other elective office but may not run for both.

2019 Retirements: In last month's bulletin Brother Rick Diffie was not included as a member who retired in 2019. My apologies!!

Travel to Port Hueneme: If you plan on traveling to Port Hueneme to work please stop by the office to fill out the required form to gain access to the Navy base. Failure to do so may cost you a work opportunity.

Vacation Claims: PMA will be mailing a vacation notice to all members identifying how many good years you have and how many weeks/hours you will be getting on your vacation check this year. If there are any discrepancies, we must file a claim on your behalf in a timely manner. Please provide all your information before the deadline as listed on the notice.

Steady Schedules: Your schedule for the following week shall be set on Friday by 3:30 PM. No schedules are to be revised after the Friday deadline!! If you are unable to work on a shift (Day/Night) you are scheduled to work, you must call a replacement for that shift. If you fail to follow these guidelines you are in violation of the Steady Agreement and you will be cited to appear before the Executive Board. If you have any questions, please call the office.

Union Meetings: It is your right and obligation to attend your union meetings. You are only required to attend one meeting every two months unless you are working, on vacation, or on the sick or injured list. **As per membership action if you sign in and leave you will be marked off as absent.
