Dues Paid for 2021: Total dues, fines, and assessments paid for your 2020 state taxes was \$5,060.00.

Paid Holidays: **Lincoln's Birthday** Monday, February 14th is paid at the overtime rate of pay, and a normal workday. **Washington's Birthday** Monday February 21st is a paid Holiday, paid at the overtime rate of pay, and a normal workday.

Nominations for all offices: Due to Covid-19, nomination forms will only be available on our web site and shall remain available until 12 noon Friday March 4, 2022. Nomination forms must be received via email at trudeau@ilwu94.org to the Secretary Treasurer no later than **12 noon Friday, March 4, 2022.**

Elections: Shall be held for all offices and Committees via mail in ballot. To apply for an elected position, you must have been a member of Local 94 and in good standing for the previous 12 months and any fines and/or assessments owed must be paid prior to close of nominations or you shall be removed from the ballot as outlined in the Constitution By-Laws.

Voting: Due to Covid-19, Voting will be done by mail only with ballots mailed on March 9, 2022 to all members with instructions on how to vote. They must be received by March 25, 2022. Failure to return your ballot by the deadline will result in a \$50 fine. If you have any questions, please contact the office.

The Run – Off Election: If needed ballots will be mailed on March 29, 2022 with instructions on how to vote. They must be received by April 14, 2022. Failure to return your ballot by the deadline will result in a \$50 fine. If you have any questions, please contact the office.

Any Candidate who wishes to have an observer on their behalf for the counting of the ballots may do so by submitting a request in writing. This request listing the name of the observer and for which candidate they will be observing for must be received by the Secretary Treasurer no later than 24 hours prior to the counting of the ballots (**6 am Thursday, March 23, 2022**). The Observer must be an active member of Local 94 and in good standing.

General Rule #1: "All active members are required to vote at all elections, regular or special, or



be fined **\$50** for failure to do so, except sick or injured members, or members on vacation and vacation is on file with the Secretary-Treasurer".

As per the Constitution and By-Laws a Trustee is prohibited from holding another elective office, a nominee may only run for the office of Trustee or for any other elective office but may not run for both.

Vacation Claims: PMA will be mailing a vacation notice to all members identifying how many good years you have and how many weeks/hours you will be getting on your vacation check this year. If there are any discrepancies, we must file a claim on your behalf in a timely manner. Please provide all your information including your vacation notice before the deadline as listed on the letter. You may contact the office for assistance.
